GRANT

KALAKAUA, By the Grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands:

By this His Royal Patent, makes known to all men, that he hath, for himself, his heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

Honolulu Sailors Home Society
a corporation duly incorporated by a Special Act of the Legislature
Approved on the 7th day of May 1855 (Civil Code of 1859 page 217)
for the consideration of

paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at
Honolulu in the Island of
Oahu and described as follows:

Lot at the east corner of Halekuanui and Makena Streets, Esplanade

Beginning at the east corner of Halekuanui and Makena Streets
and running

N 51° 03' E	124.8	feet along the north side of Makena Street
S 37° 50' E	91.9	feet to the corner of Halekuanui Street (Enterprise Mill)
S 51° 03' W	137.7	feet to the north side of Halekuanui Street
S 30° 25' W	100.0	feet to the initial point, <u>2480 Square Feet.</u>
