GRANT.

KALAKAUA, By the Grace of God, King of the Hawaiian Islands:

By this His Royal Patent, makes known to all men, that he hath, for himself, his heirs and successors, this day granted and given unto

M. G. Ashley

for the consideration of One thousand and Ninety (\$1090.-) Dollars paid into the Royal Exchequer, all that piece of Land situate at South Slope of Punchbowl Hill, Honolulu in the Island of Oahu and described as follows:

Beginning at centre of Granite post, at west angle of this lot, on waiaka side of Thurston Avenue, and 75 ft North east from angle of Street thence running by true bearings:
N. 13° 45' W. 200 ft. along into the City.
N. 76° 15' E. 200 ft. ~~Sub. road~~ (Proposed road).
S. 13° 45' E. 200 ft. ~~Sub. road~~ (Proposed road).
S. 76° 15' W. 200 ft. ~~Sub. road~~ (Proposed road).
